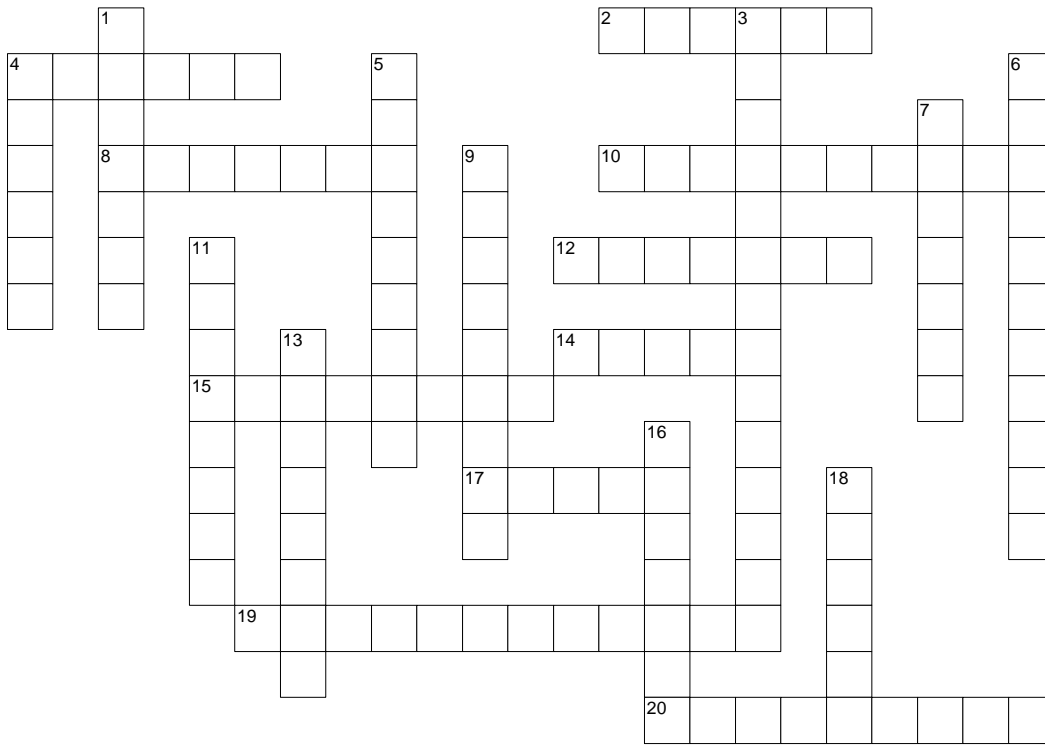


## Percussion Instruments of the Orchestra



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### Across

- 2 Tubes hung vertically
- 4 A pair of hardwood cylinders
- 8 Metal bell
- 10 Wooden frame with metal disks
- 12 Most important orchestral percussion instrument.
- 14 A scraper with notches
- 15 Steel rod bent this way
- 17 Long, single-headed drum played with the hands
- 19 Carved from hardwood into round shapes, hollow, set of five
- 20 Sounds like the cracking of a whip

### Down

- 1 Has a tongue and a grooved cylinder mounted in a frame
- 3 Instruments on which sound is produced by beating a skin.
- 4 Small gourd covered with strung beads
- 5 Wooden bars with a tubular resonator below. Arranged like a piano
- 6 Small pellets mounted in rows
- 7 Most important orchestral percussion instrument.
- 9 Hollow rectangular block
- 11 Hollow sides, clapped together

- 13 A pair of shallow cylindrical drums
- 16 Filled with seeds
- 18 Held between the knees
