

Stand Etiquette

1. Remember that you and your stand partner are a team. Be cooperative and positive with one another.
2. Work together to determine the stand height and distance from the two of you.
3. If you are the inside player, it is your responsibility to turn pages. Be alert for fast page turns. They are usually marked “**V.s.**” (Volti subito). which means “turn suddenly”.
4. Take the initiative to mark in your teacher’s suggestions. If your stand partner is writing in the music, help him by holding the stand still.
5. Be considerate of your neighbors on the stage. Know the name of your stand partner and the names of those around you. This will help to create a more positive atmosphere in which to work and play!
